

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that the intensity of our carbon emissions will decrease over the next ten years from 6.1 tCO2e/FTE to 3 tCO2e/FTE by 2033. This is a reduction of 51.6%
